Road to Emmaus Game

<u>SET UP</u>

You will need six paper or plastic cups, bowls – or whatever. Each cup is labeled – write on the cups, or attach a slip of paper with the label – or whatever. Three of the cups have question marks on them, one has "Take a Point" written on it, another has "Lose a Point" written on it, and the last cup has "Lose a Turn" written on it. You will also need a small ball that can be tossed into the cups and a way to keep score. You will also need a copy of the questions.

RULES

Put the group of paper cups a few feet away from a throwing line, determined by the anticipated skill of your family! Have the first player stand behind the throwing line (or behind a chair, or whatever) and throw a small ball toward the cups. If the ball misses the cups – the turn is forfeited. It the ball lands in "Lose A Point" the person loses one point. If the ball lands in "Take a Point" then the player can take a point from any other person. (Keeping score will be important.) It the ball lands in "Lose a Turn" that persons turn is over. If the ball lands in a cup with a question mark – the person must answer a question about the Bible story. The game continues until all the questions have been answered. The person with the most points wins.

The Questions:

You can simply do the questions in order as the appear below, or print them out, cut them up, and let players draw a question from a bag— or whatever. You can also add a minute timer to use while the person ponders the question. If the question is answered correctly before the minute timer runs out, that person will receive a point. If they are not correct, they do not receive a point. Then the next person takes their turn and so on.

Options

1. Using Bibles: People can use their Bibles to help them answer the questions. Everyone will have their Bible open to the page where the story appears. When giving the answer, the person will have to answer the question AND cite the verse number where the answer comes from. They will receive 2 points if they can do both. The person will receive one point if they can only answer one part of the question correctly.

2. The next person may answer the question if the first person cannot come up with an answer. If the next person can answer the question correctly in one minute, that person will receive the point and then it is their turn to throw the ball for their own turn.
