NOT ASHAMED

Pastor Joel McQueen

2 Timothy

2 Timothy is Paul's final and most personal letter. He is in Roman prison for the second time, but this time he knows he is going to die. He is writing to his protégé, his closest friend, his "beloved son" in the faith, Timothy. He wants Timothy to come to see him as soon as possible, but to do so is very dangerous. Timothy is going to need encouragement, courage, and to be UNASHAMED of Paul and the Gospel.

WHY SHOULD WE BE UNASHAMED OF THE GOSPEL - EVEN WHEN IT MAY COST US?

GOD HAS PREPARED AND EMPOWERED US (vv. 3-7)

Timothy had a grandmother and mother who poured into him, and Timothy had a sincere faith.

"If I see further than others, it is because I stand on the shoulders of giants." –Isaac Newton

Who is pouring into you? Who are you pouring faith into?

God has gifted us and given us the spirit of power, love, and self-control.

Do you know your spiritual gift?

The boldness to represent the Gospel doesn't come from you – so lean into prayer!

THE GOSPEL IS ALL ABOUT GOD'S COSTLY GRACE (vv. 9-12)

The Gospel isn't about you; it's about what God has done in Jesus!

"Cheap grace is grace we bestow on ourselves. Cheap grace is the preaching of forgiveness without requiring repentance, baptism without church discipline, communion without confession...cheap grace is grace without discipleship, grace without the cross, grace without Jesus Christ, living and incarnate." -Bonhoeffer

When people reject the Gospel, they are rejecting Jesus – not you.

"If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. 19 If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you." John 15:18-19

EXAMPLES OF FEARLESS, COSTLY FAITH (VV.13-18)

The (+) Example of Paul (v.13-14)

Discipleship isn't just "do what I say." Discipleship is "live how I live" – with Jesus at the center of everything!

1 Corinthians 11:1 "Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ."

The (-) Example of the Asians, Phygelus, and Hermogenes (v.15)

The (+) Example of Onesiphorus (vv. 16-18)

Don't be ashamed of the Gospel because God has prepared you, empowered you, saved you, and called you to fearless faith.

BIG IDEA: TAKE YOUR STAND, BECAUSE YOU ARE IN GOD'S HANDS!

Challenge Question: What does the Gospel cost you? And if the answer to that question is "nothing," then are you unashamedly and boldly living for Jesus?

Some Application Ideas:

Give something up for LENT and spend that time in prayer.

Pray for our missionaries, pray for the persecuted church.

Pray about who is in your life you could share the Gospel with. Write their name on a sticky note and put it on your bathroom mirror.

Is there something you would be unwilling to lose for being Christian? Write it down and pray it through.
