#### TOP FIVE REGRETS OF THE DYING IN WESTERN SOCIETY

- 1) I wish I'd had the courage to live a life true to myself, not the life others expected of me.
- 2) I wish I hadn't worked so hard.
- 3) I wish I had the courage to express my feelings.
- 4) I wish I had stayed in touch with my friends.
- 5) I wish I had let myself be happier.

A glaring contrast to Paul's final charge to Timothy. Paul knows he is going to die and doesn't have regrets, and he wants to make sure Timothy lives his life so that he doesn't have regrets at the end either. (2 Tim 4:6-7)

THE SETTING IS THE COMING OF JESUS AND JUDGMENT BY HIM (2 Tim 4:1, 8) Solemn/serious, but also hopeful

The judgment of Christians is often misunderstood.

Too obsessed/confident or avoiding end times all together?

Background on the Bema Seat (1 Cor 3, Rom 14, 2 Cor 5)

PREACH THE WORD (2 Tim 4:2-5)

Preach = κήρυξον = Kay-Roo-Zone

To declare the news – the news that Jesus is risen and Lord (Rom 10:9-10)

"If it's worth believing, it's worth sharing!"

It's for everyone, not just "Billy-Graham-like" evangelists.

Ready in and out of season (saturated in scripture)

Reprove and rebuke (Gospel messages must talk about sin!)

Exhort (The Gospel is GOOD NEWS!)

Complete patience and teaching

Paul at the End (2 Tim 4:6-7) Sacrifice metaphor (drink offering)

Athletic metaphor (fight/race)

Live for your last day. Share your faith.

If you were put on trial for being a Christian, would there be enough evidence to convict you?

What faith medal are you running for?
