RESCUED

Pastor Joel McQueen

2 Timothy: Chapter 4:16-18

The neat little details at the end of 2 Timothy help us to reconstruct a historically probable end to the Apostle Paul's life.

The Apostle Paul says, just prior to being martyred, that the Lord rescued him and will rescue him. Do you need a rescue from the Lord today?

WHAT DOES PAUL MEAN BY 'THE LORD RESCUED HIM AND WILL RESCUE HIM? (2 Timothy 4:16-18)

Paul clearly does NOT mean that God spares him suffering and trials.

The repeated command of the letter is to co-suffer. (2 Tim 1:8; 2:3)

Everyone who pursues godliness with be persecuted. (2 Tim 3:12)

Paul means God was WITH him in his trials. (2 Tim 4:16-17)

Even if you are standing alone, God is by your side!

God never, ever leaves us and what we need is more of His presence. (Rom 8)

Paul means that God gives him strength through his trials. (2 Tim 4:17)

God gave Paul the courage and strength to complete his ministry to the Gentiles.

Phil. 4:13 – in context it means: God gives me strength to be content and trust in Him no matter what I am facing.

Daniel and the lion's den - Paul sees it as a MIRACLE of protection that he is still alive after his initial hearing!

God still does miracles today! Do you need a miracle? Ask Him!

Paul means by rescue is that he is going to see Jesus face to face! (2 Tim 4:18)

Bonhoeffer said at the end of his life: "May God in His mercy lead us through these times, but above all, may He lead us to Himself!"

My spiritual mentor ultimately died of cancer. It wasn't that God didn't answer our prayers for rescue. Through treatment God never left her side. God gave her strength to witness to doctors and nurses all over Mayo clinic. And ultimately, God brought her safely home to Heaven.

BIG IDEA

Rescue doesn't mean no pain; it means you gain Jesus.
