THE IMPORTANCE OF AN INTRODUCTION!

Ephesians 1:1-10

"Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To God's holy people in Ephesus, the faithful in Christ Jesus: Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight.

In love he predestined us for adoption to sonship through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will— to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves. In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that he lavished on us. With all wisdom and understanding, he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ, to be put into effect when the times reach their fulfillment—to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ."

Be 'In Christ' and 'In communion with the Saints' and you'll be able to handle being 'In Ephesus.'

You will not only survive but be able to thrive through the power of the Holy Spirit in Jesus' Name.

Then we can fulfill our Lord's prayer to the Father at the Last Supper in John 17 that we be in the world but not of the world...consecrated in truth and sent by Christ to help redeem the world.
