CHANGE OF HEART

Pastor Joel McQueen

MATTHEW 15:21-28

The number one rule of biblical interpretation is "context is king," and many people misinterpret or are confused by this because they do not pay enough attention to the context! The previous story unit is talking about spiritually clean/unclean people based on externals, leaving the Pharisees, and that what comes out of your mouth reveals what is in your heart.

THE STORY STARTS WITH A FOREIGN MISSIONS TRIP

The disciples would have wanted to hide/be left alone (v.21)

We can be the same way today:

The least-reached people are in: central Africa, Middle East, Southeast-Asia (3 billion people), which are also the areas with the least number of missionaries headed to them ... why?

Western Minnesota churches attitude towards Somalians growing up was not favorable/seen as an opportunity for missions ... why?

A WOMEN IN DESPERATE NEED AND JESUS' ODD RESPONSE

Jesus did not answer her a word ... why? (v.23)

Jesus was sent only to Israel ... true or untrue? (v.24)

Not right to give the children's bread to dogs ... why? (v. 26)

EVEN A CRUMB FROM JESUS IS ENOUGH TO SAVE

Who are "those people" to us?

Jesus came to save *everyone:* regardless of ethnic group, sex/gender, religion/culture, social status, past-sins, background, etc...

APPLICATION

Privately this week, write out five names of relationships that you have with people who are "far off" from God (perhaps people who you find difficult to get along with). Begin to pray for an opportunity to tell them that Jesus loves them and died for them. Jesus wants "those people" to follow Him; He wants you to follow Him in reaching them!

Because Jesus came to save - everyone.

And even a crumb from Jesus is enough!
