MATTHEW 14:22-33 AND ACTS 4:1-20

PETER BEFORE – WHERE FEAR RULES

Jesus walks on water (Matthew 14:29-31)

"Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?"

Jesus and His disciples in Caesarea Philippi (Matthew 16:13-23)

"Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; for you are not setting your mind on God's interests, but on man's."

Peter disowns Jesus three times (Mark 14:66-72)

"He (Peter) began to call down curses, and he swore to them, 'I don't know this man you're talking about.'"

PETER AFTER – WHERE COURAGE OVERRULES

Peter and John before the Sanhedrin (Acts 4:13)

“When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished, and they took note that these men had been with Jesus.”

Peter and John respond to the Sanhedrin (Acts 4:19-20)

“Which is right in God’s eyes: to listen to you, or to him? You be the judges! As for us, we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard.”

Peter’s words to those facing persecution (1 Peter 4:12ff)

“Therefore, gird your minds for action, keep sober in spirit, fix your hopes completely on the grace to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. And beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal among you which comes upon you for your testing, as though some strange thing were happening to you, but to the degree that you share the sufferings of Christ, keep on rejoicing so that also with the revelation of his glory you may rejoice with his exultation.”
