STEPHEN: A SPIRIT-FILLED LIFE

Acts 6:1-15; 7:1-2, 51-60

"In those days when the number of disciples was increasing, the Hellenistic Jews among them complained against the Hebraic Jews because their widows were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food. So the Twelve gathered all the disciples together and said, "It would not be right for us to neglect the ministry of the Word of God in order to wait on tables. Brothers and sisters, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them and will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the Word. This proposal pleased the whole group. They chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit..."

...While they were stoning him, Stephen prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." Then he fell on his knees and cried out, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them." When he had said this, he fell asleep."

STEPHEN WAS FULL OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

Stephen was one who did not seek to control the Holy Spirit, but was willing to be controlled by the Spirit.

Human achievement or divine appointment?

STEPHEN WAS FULL OF WISDOM

Do we as a church possess the spirit of wisdom? Are we guided by leaders who are wise, not just smart? Are we guided by leaders who have been given understanding from above, as it is something that is given, not concocted by looking 'inward?' Do we have leaders who are able to interpret the times with the breadth of history as a guide? Do we have leaders who understand what we have sought to do in the past, thereby informing what we should do in the present and in the days to come?

STEPHEN WAS FULL OF FAITH

People who are full of faith are people who are faithful!
