INTRODUCTION

The call to go...and preach.

God, Jonah, and Nineveh

God uses imperfect people.

THE WHOLE STORY OF HUMANITY

We are disobedient and lost. (Ephesians 2:1-3)

GOD'S CHARACTER

Jonah got mad. (He didn't see what God saw.)

God runs after humanity to redeem us. (Ephesians 2:4-10) God offers grace and a way of salvation. (Ephesians 2:5, 8) God provided a huge fish to swallow Jonah.
