UNFORGIVEN

Matthew 18:21-35

FORGIVENESS IS KEY

Forgiveness was central to Jesus' teaching, and Jesus was clear in His teaching to His disciples that God will NOT forgive us if we refuse to forgive others (See Matthew 5:7, 6:14-15, and Luke 17:4.)

In Timothy Keller's book "Forgiveness," he points out: Our culture has an acute sense of justice but despises forgiveness." (Example social justice warriors and cancel culture.)

The question of Peter: "What's the limit to forgiveness, seven times?" (See verse 21.)

WHY SHOULD OUR FORGIVENESS BE UNLIMITED?

The Parable of the Unforgiving Servant (verse 23-34)

The King is settling his accounts (money he entrusted to his servants) and there is a servant who owes an impossible amount (550 billion dollars).

We typically underestimate how bad our sin is: we all deserve eternal punishment in Hell.

Jonathan Edwards "Sinners in the Hands of an Angry God"

The servant begs for mercy and the King forgives his debt!

The Gospel is that the infinitely precious blood of the Son of God was spilled to pay our debt of sin, that we owed to God.

But the servant turns around and incomprehensibly assaults and demands payment from a fellow servant who owes him (\$20,000).

It's living exactly opposite of the Gospel.

"You are the least like God when you choose not to forgive." -John MacArthur

The King "unforgives" the debt. He hands the servant over to the tormentors until he can pay. So also, God will hand you over to torment if you don't forgive.

Caveat: Forgiveness is not the same as reconciliation (a restored relationship). Repentance (turning away from sin and towards relationship) on the part of the sinner is an important first step that is assumed in this story.

Caveat: In cases of abuse, involve authorities. Send people who break the law to jail. Discipline = love. Boundaries = wisdom.

APPLICATION

If you wrestle with unforgiveness...

Choose to say aloud: I forgive, for
Pray for the person who hurt you as often as they come to mind. Trust God that justice will be done in His timing. Forgiveness is not forgetting
Get help from Christian community if you need it

Holocaust survivor Corrie Ten Boom came face to face with one of the guards at Ravensbruck (the place where her sister died) during a speaking tour in Germany where she had shared the Gospel. What would she do?

BIG IDEA

Unlimited forgiveness frees you from torment. So, forgive just as God in Christ forgave you. (Ephesians 4:32)
